




Click on "Change to English" to turn on the microphone option

If your computer or phone is set to English and microphone is allowed on the browser, then you can use the "Practice" feature to say new words to learn and practice your pronunciation and speech in English.

!!! Before speaking to your computer's or phone's microphone, make sure you are in a quiet place.



When you mispronounce words, it highlights which sound you said wrong and gives tips of how to improve.


